2. Judging

This competition will be judged using the international judging system.

3. Entries

We are only accepting online entries. Entries can be made via the website **www.dundeeiceskatingclub.org**. The official entry forms must be used. This entry will only be accepted when the bank transfer has been received.

3.1

The entries should reach the organiser no later than **Friday 5th of July. Please ensure entry is sent in good time to avoid disappointment.**

3.2

For UK skaters you must be an eligible member of British Ice Skating.

3.3

Entries for individual events will be accepted in order of receipt of application forms and entry fee, and places may be limited due to available ice time.

3.4

All Competitors must be ready to skate at least half an hour before the time stated on the timetable. The timetable is provisional and will be subject to change.

3.5

If any of the categories are over subscribed, they may be divided by age. For Beginners to Level 3, the age is calculated as at the closing date. For the ISU categories, age is calculated as at the previous 1st of July.

3.6

The Tayside Trophy Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without reason.

3.7

Withdrawals after the closing date will not be refunded, the Tayside Trophy Committee decision is final.

3.8

UK Skaters Only, if the test requirements for the category entered are incorrect at the closing date, the entry will be considered invalid and will be withdrawn and therefore should have no refund.

3.9

The cost for all events is **£60 for 1 event**. Unless entering both the Short and Free program of the Advanced Novice, Junior or Senior events, in which case the cost is at a discounted rate of **£95 for both events**. Payment for this event is by bank transfer only.

4. Practice Ice

Practice ice will be available during the event. Information regarding practices will be made available on the event website www.dundeeiceskatingclub.org shortly after the closing date.

5. Music

All competitors shall furnish music of excellent quality on CD format only. All discs must show the exact running time when submitted at the time of registration. Each programme (Short/Free) must be recorded on one track and on a separate disc. The discs must show the competition event, competitor's name and their nationality. Please make sure you have a spare CD. All music can be picked up from the registration desk at the end of the event.

6. Planned Programme Content

The Planned Programme Content Sheet will be able to be entered online along with the entry form and **MUST** be completed. It is mandatory that the Planned Programme Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each skater in English using the terminology for the elements listed in respective ISU Communication.

7. Accreditation

The official accreditation will be available at the ice rink upon arrival.

8. Presentation of Medals

The first three best-placed competitors in each event will be announced and honoured.

9. Insurance/Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Tayside Trophy, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

10. List of competitors and Timetable/Draws

The draws for all categories will be done electronically/automatically, randomized by the ISU Judging system-computer. The starting orders will be published the day before the event takes place.

12. Meals, Lodging, and travel expenses

Any ISU Member Federation wishing to send a judge will receive a 50% reduction on the entry fee for all skaters from that Member Federation. The Organising Committee will cover on-site

board and accommodation for any sent judges. The ISU Member Federation is responsible for the sent judges travel arrangements.

The organiser will not provide and cover the expenses for travel, rooms and meals for accepted competitors, or their coaches.

13. General information

13.1

The Tayside Trophy Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or add events to the final competition list subject to entries. Full refunds will be made to all competitors not offered entry.

13.2

Competitors and coaches are requested to read the Technical Requirements for the events carefully. These have been set according to published ISU 2019/2020 regulations for competitions and championships, also the most up to date BIS Generic Criteria 2019/2020.

13.3

Any photography or videography is NOT permitted on or off the ice during competitions. No Face Time or similar Video of the competition under any circumstances. Anyone breaking this regulation will be asked to leave the rink complex and will not be permitted to return.

13.4

All skaters will be filmed for IJS.

13.5

Test passes for UK skaters will only be considered after the event when all checks by BIS have been made.

13.6

Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these general rules and regulations.

13.7

Competitors, Parents and Coaches are reminded that the organisers, judges and officials are all volunteers, without whom this competition would not be possible. Please treat them with the respect and politeness they deserve.

13.8

The Tayside Trophy committee cannot be held responsible for events outside of their control, e.g. ice or power failure ect.

If anything happens out of our control we will not be held responsible for expenses incurred by competitors.
